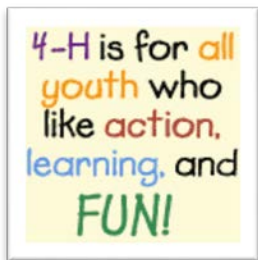

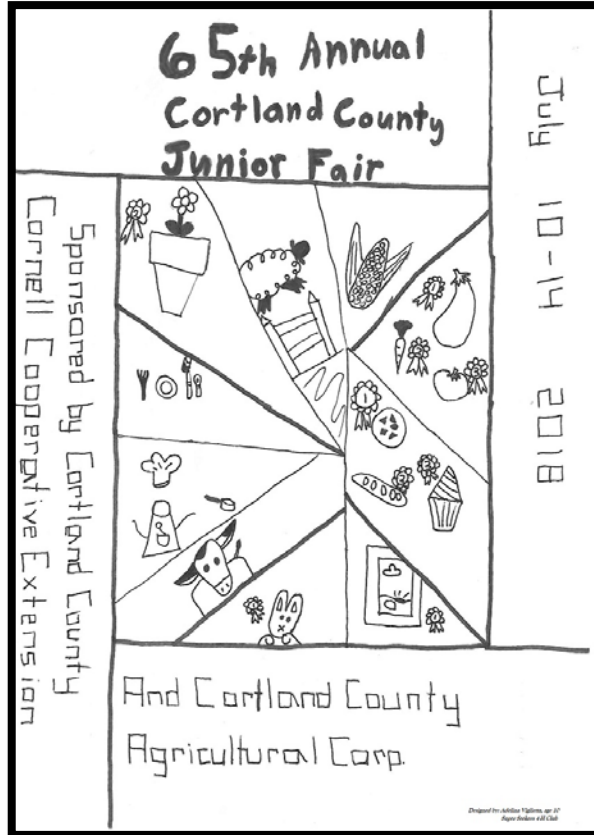

Choosing a 4-H Project

A 4-H project is a topic that a 4-H member chooses to work on, either in a 4-H club or as an independent member. 4-H clubs offer different kinds of projects, depending on the interests of the members. A 4-H project is something a 4-H member learns to do with the help of leaders and parents.

As you start a new 4-H year, and your thoughts go to “what projects should we do this year?”—here are some tips for choosing a 4-H project:

- What interests you?
- You can do most 4-H projects on your own or within your 4-H club. Some projects have county workshops. Watch the Clover Dispatch for information on these workshops.
- How much will the project cost?
- Are you interested in a livestock project? You can do some animal projects without owning an animal, ask at the 4-H office about leasing an animal.
- Do you have the equipment you’ll need to complete your project?
- Can your parents or 4-H leader help you with the project?
- What skills will you learn and will the project help you grow as an individual?
- Some projects are chosen for the 4-H club as a group, and hopefully you can give your input about what you would like to do.
- How much time will the project take? Some projects take a full year to complete, while others take just a few days or weeks. You may want to do only one or two projects in your first year of 4-H.
- Does the project sound like it's fun and worth the effort?
- Is it appropriate for your age?
- Talk to other 4-H members about their projects, and you may find some new ideas.

Choosing a new project and seeing it through to completion is a valuable educational process, and can be a great confidence builder. With the proper support from parents, volunteers, and 4-H staff, 4-H members can complete their chosen projects and learn many valuable life skills.

4. Be sure to notify the 4-H office by Tuesday, October 2nd regarding the location of the exhibit. (607-391-2660)
5. Awards for the display will be recognized at Achievement Night on October 27th.

NATIONAL 4-H WEEK POSTER CONTEST - One poster per club or individual. (Poster should not be part of "display contest.")

1. Posters must be on standard poster board, 22" by 28".
2. Poster must include the following information:
 - o **National 4-H Week dates - October 7-14, 2018**
 - o 4-H club name and contact info for the 4-H Office: Address: 60 Central Ave., Rm 140, Cortland, NY Phone: 607-391-2660 - Website: Cortland.cce.cornell.edu
 - o Incorporate the theme: "**4-H Grows in Cortland County**"
3. Any media may be used: paint, magic markers, etc.
4. Poster must be put up in a public place in the county by 6:00PM on Friday October 6th.
5. Be sure to notify the 4-H Office by Tuesday October 2nd as to where the posters are placed, (607-391-2660). Posters will be evaluated by the 4-H Office for judging. Please ask the storekeeper to save the poster until the 4-H office picks it up!
6. All posters will be on display and award recognition during 4-H Achievement Night program on October 27th.

NATIONAL 4-H WEEK ESSAY CONTEST – Topic: "**4-H Grows in Cortland County**"

1. Awards will be offered in 3 age categories:
 - o Ages 8-11, essay must be at least 50 words.
 - o Ages 12-15, essay must be at least 150 words
 - o Ages 16 and older, essay must be at least 250 words.

ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES

- New 4-H Clubs must be established by 12/31/18 to get credit for the year
- Deadline for re-enrollment for **all** clubs and independent members is 11/1/18.

- Current club members and independent members must re-enroll by 12/31/18 to avoid late charges on enrollment fees.
- **All** youth must be re-enrolled by 3/31/19 in order to show animals at the Cortland Jr. Fair.
- New Member Enrollment is due within 30 days of the first 4-H club meeting attended, but before participation in any county, regional or state event or activity.
- New members who enroll after June 1, 2019 will not be able to enter exhibits for evaluation at the Cortland County Jr. Fair or the New York State Fair.

NOTES

- Members not enrolled will not receive the Clover Dispatch and are not covered by our insurance.
- 4-H age—youth must be 8 yrs. old on or before 12/31/18, and cannot have reached their 19th birthday by 1/1/19.
- Cloverbuds need to be 5 yrs. old on or before 12/31/18 during the club year, and cannot have reached their 8th birthday by 1/1/19.

ANNUAL ENROLLMENT FEE - Please include enrollment fee with forms.

- \$5.00/youth for Cortland County residents, with a maximum of \$25/family (late enrollment fee after December 31st: \$15/per youth – no family maximum).
- \$15.00/youth for out-of-county residents, with a maximum of \$45/family (late enrollment fee after December 31st: \$25/per youth-no family maximum).
