# **SECTION 03 - DAIRY CATTLE**

<u>Housing Location: Dairy Cattle Barn</u> Rules and Regulations 2020 New York State Livestock Requirements & General Rules apply



- (a) Exhibitor must have registration papers available to identify animal(s) shown and to establish ownership as may be necessary. An animal with registered papers pending will NOT be allowed to show.
- (b) Dairy Cattle must be <u>purebred & (87%) registered</u> in the Exhibitor's name by <u>June</u> <u>1, 2020</u> (or a non-ownership must be provided).
- (c) Exhibitor must provide and have registration papers and non-owned certificate with the animal at check in, so that superintendent and veterinarian can authorize entry and housing.
- (d) **BVD-PI Testing** must have been done.
- (e) It is recommended that any animal over 1-year of age have its horns removed.
- (f) NON-OWNED ANIMAL(s) accompanied with a **non-ownership certificate** must be properly filled out, along with registration papers to prove designation. Website: <u>http://cortland.cce.cornell.edu/4-h-youth/cortland-jr-fair</u>

## <u>New This Year: 2020 Dairy Cattle Section:</u>

- Youth may <u>register and show</u> TWO (2) Non-Owned Dairy Cattle animals at the fair. A designated non-owned project animal must be shown <u>only by</u> registered exhibitor and not by owner.
- Exhibitor must accompany the animal entering the fairgrounds.
- **Dual designation** of one animal is not permitted (*except siblings*) see page 14 in the general rules.
- No Non-Owned Animal in Market Class
- (g) ANIMAL PROJECT RECORD one project record is needed for one project animal that a 4-H'er has. If showing more than one species, the 4-H'er should only pick one animal.
- (h) <u>Premiums will be paid</u> on a maximum of <u>ONE animal per class</u>, per exhibitor.
- (i) Exhibitors must be neatly and appropriately dressed in Plain White Clothes showing their animals. No farm shirts or any shirts with printing or design permitted in dairy cattle classes.
- (j) Dairy cattle showmanship preliminary classes will start on Thursday at 1:00 p.m. with final classes to begin at 7:00 p.m. (If necessary the Dairy Advisory Committee reserves the right to adjust class size for finals).
- (k) Dairy Cattle conformation classes will be judged on Friday 9:00 a.m. The "Danish System of Awards" will be used to place the animals.
- (1) Barn closes to the public at 10:00 p.m. LIGHTS OUT in the barn by 11:00 p.m. Nonexhibitors are not allowed to stay in the barn. Background Checks required on all Chaperones.

- (m) • **In Place**: Animals in place on Tuesday, 6:00 p.m.
  - Released: All animals will be released on Sunday between 6:00-8:00 a.m.
  - Dismantle & Cleaning: One (1) Rep from Club/family MUST be present to help and we encourage all exhibitors/parents to help with dismantling and cleaning your areas and pens. \*It is not the responsibility of the staff or Fairboard directors and volunteers!
- "FAN" must be provided by Exhibitor for their animal's comfort. **(n)**
- **(0)** 4-H club signs and display are encouraged.

- 14 \*Spring Calf born March 1, 2020 to April 3, 2020
- 15 Winter Calf born after Nov. 30 2019 & before March 1<sup>st</sup> (or by Feb. 29<sup>th</sup>), 2020
- 16 Fall Calf born after Aug. 31, 2019 & before Dec. 1, 2019
- 17 Summer Yearling born after May 31, 2019 & before Sept. 1, 2019
- 18 Spring Yearling born after February 28, 2019 & before June 1, 2019 not in milk
- 19 Winter Yearling born after Nov. 30, 2018 & before March 2, 2019 not in milk
- 20 Fall Yearling (not in milk) born after Aug. 31, 2018 & before Dec.1, 2018
- 21 Fall Yearling (in milk) born after Aug. 31, 2018 & before Dec.1, 2018

- Jr. Cow 2 Years born after Feb. 28, 2018 & before Sept 1, 2018
- 23 Sr. Cow 2 Years born after Aug 31, 2017 & March 1, 2018
- Jr. Cow 3 Years born after Feb. 28, 2017 & before Sept. 1, 2017
- 25 Sr. Cow 3 Years born after Aug. 31, 2016 & before Mar. 1, 2017
- 26 Cow 4 Years born after Aug. 31, 2015 & before Sept 1, 2016
- 27 Dry Cow 4 Years/Younger, must have not been shown in the milking classes.
- 28 Dry Cow 5 Years/Older; may not be shown in the milking classes.
- **29** Cow 5 Years, born after Aug. 31, 2014 & before Sept. 1, 2015
- **30** Aged Cow, 6 Years/older, born before Sept. 1, 2014

## **SPECIAL AWARD CLASSES** (no premiums)

- 31 Supreme Heifer Class All Jr. Champions to return for honors
- 32 100,000 lb. Cow cows that has produced 100,000 lbs. of milk, *must bring* registration & DHI papers to the ring.
- 33 Best Uddered Cow (Open) all animals of milking age, with all breeds competing
- **34** Best Animal Bred and Owned by Exhibitor, any age, any breed. Young Dairy Herd – open to Junior exhibitor owning 3 purebred animals of any
- 35 age & breed. The exhibitors may have assistance in showing the group, but in the ring must keep them all together. The 3 animals must be the same breed/owned by the exhibitor.
- **36** Produce of Dam to consist of two animals, both to be the progeny of one cow owned by the exhibitor. Dam of the calves does not have to be owned by exhibitor.
- 37 Dam-Daughter
- 38 Club/Family Groups a club may select 3 animals of one or more breeds, but not more than one animal per exhibitor.

All awards are listed in the back of the fair book and may be changed or deleted if necessary by staff or judge.
