

SECTION 04 -DAIRY GOATS

Housing Location: Ag. Corp. Building
Rules and Regulations 2020
New York State Livestock Requirements
& General Rules apply



- (a) ADGA tattoo is acceptable identification for **scrapie requirements** when animal is accompanied by registration papers. **No Ear Tags are required!**
- (b) **Ownership:** A duplicate registration application from ADGA will be accepted on an animal under 6 months of age on a registered or recorded animal, a signed bill of sale or certificate of transfer attached to the duplicate will be accepted.
- (c) Dairy goats must be owned and registered in the exhibitor's name by **June 1, 2020.**
- (d) **NON-OWNED ANIMAL(s)** accompanied with a **non-ownership certificate** must be properly filled out, along with registration papers to prove designation.
 - Youth are **limited to ONE (1) non-owned animal** per species at the fair. (i.e. Beef, Poultry, Rabbits, Swine & Sheep)

 - Youth may register **TWO (2) Non-Owned Animal per species-** "***but may only show one***" at the fair. (i.e. Dairy Goats & Meat Goats).
 - **A designated non-owned project animal** must be shown only by registered exhibitor and not by youth owner and must accompany the animal entering the fairgrounds.
 - **Dual designation of one animal is not permitted.**
 - **No Non-Owned Animal in Market Class**
- (e) Only does registered or recorded with ADGA, AGS or CGS are eligible for State Fair contests.
- (f) No Bucks may be shown and No animals with horns may be shown.
- (g) **Entry Limit:** a (**maximum 10 entries**) per exhibitor will be permitted. Premiums will be paid on a maximum of **ONE animal per class**, per exhibitor.
- (h) **ANIMAL PROJECT RECORD** - one project record is needed for one project animal that a 4-H'er has. If showing more than one species, the 4-H'er should only pick one animal. Website: <http://cortland.cce.cornell.edu/4-h-youth/cortland-jr-fair>
- (i) Exhibitor must have registration papers and/or non-owned certificate with the animal for vet check in – to authorize entry and housing.
- (j) Participation in Dairy Goat Showmanship Class is Mandatory!
- (k) Jr Division - Does under 24 months of age -not in milk and have never freshened.
- (l) Senior Division consists of milking does of any age, including dry and precocious milker (does 24 mos. & over that have never freshened will not be shown).
- (m) Exhibitors to be dressed in show whites (*no advertising/or farm name on clothing*).
- (n) All milking does must in place by 6 p.m. - Preliminary contest milk out at 7:00 p.m.
- (o) 4-H Club signs and displays encouraged
- (p) **"Fan"** must be provided by Exhibitor for their animal's comfort.
- (q) Barn closes at 10:00 p.m. – Lights out 11:00 p.m.! No exhibitors to stay in the barn.

- (r) **In Place:** Animals in place on Tuesday, 6:00 p.m.
Released: All animals will be released on Sunday between 6:00-8:00 a.m.
Dismantle & Cleaning: One (1) Rep from Club/family **MUST** be present to help and we encourage all exhibitors/parents to help with dismantling and cleaning your areas and pens. **It is not the responsibility of the staff, Fairboard and/or volunteers!*

Age Groups based on age as of day of show

JUNIOR DOES: *Any doe under 24 months of age that has never freshened.*

- 45 3 ½ -5 months of age
46 5 months to younger than 9 months of age
47 9 months to younger than 16 months of age
48 16 months to younger than 24 months of age

SENIOR DOES: *Consists of milking does of any age, including dry and precocious milkers. (Does - age 24 months and over that have never freshened will not be shown).*

- 49 Younger than 2 years of age (in milk)
50 2 years to younger than 3 years of age
51 3 years to younger than 5 years of age
52 5 years of age and older

SPECIAL AWARD DAIRY GOAT BREED CLASSES: (no premiums)

- 53 Dam-Daughter (must be owned by same exhibitor)
54 (A) **PRODUCTION AWARD** – (will not be offered in 2020)
