Rules and Regulations 2020

New York State Livestock Requirements

& General apply - Including all Scrapies regulations.

- (a) Up-to-date Market Records are mandatory for each animal. Records are to be turned in to the 4-H Fair Office immediately after sale. Premiums will be withheld if records are not turned in.
- (b) Ewes can be shown in market classes or breeding classes, but NOT both.
- (c) All sheep exhibitors are required to show in a showmanship class and No farm shirts or any shirts with printing or design permitted in classes.
- (d) Each exhibitor must groom and show his/her own animal.
- (e) All sheep must have their tails docked and healed prior to fair.
- (f) ANIMAL PROJECT RECORD one project record is needed for one project animal that a 4-H'er has. If showing more than one species, the 4-H'er should only pick one animal. Website: http://cortland.cce.cornell.edu/4-h-youth/cortland-jr-fair
- (g) NON-OWNED ANIMAL(s) accompanied with a non-ownership certificate must be properly filled out, along with registration papers to prove designation.
 - Youth are <u>limited to ONE (1) non-owned animal</u> per species at the fair. (i.e. Beef, Poultry, Rabbits, Swine & Sheep)
 - Website: http://cortland.cce.cornell.edu/4-h-youth/cortland-jr-fair
 - Youth may register **TWO** (2) <u>Non-Owned Animal per species</u>- "but may only show one" at the fair. (i.e. Dairy Goats & Meat Goats).
 - A designated non-owned project animal must be shown only by registered exhibitor and not by youth owner and must accompany the animal entering the fairgrounds.
 - Dual designation of one animal is not permitted.
 - No Non-Owned Animal in Market Class
- (h) Exhibitor must have registration papers and non-owned certificate with the animal for check in so that superintendent and veterinarian can authorize entry and housing.
- (i) READ INSERT GUIDELINES FOR MARKET CLASS:

Weight- In Wednesday – 8:00 a.m. Note: Market Sale Checks will be mailed to Exhibitor after fair, once exhibitor has met the **two final requirements listed**:

- 1. Market Record Book must be turn in no later than Saturday, July 11th -10:00 a.m.
- 2. Must help dismantle/clean of the sheep area on Sunday, July 12th @ 6-8:00 a.m.
- (j) In Place: Animals in place on Tuesday, 6:00 p.m.

Released: All animals will be released on Sunday between 6:00-8:00 a.m.

Dismantle & Cleaning: One (1) Rep from Club/family MUST be present to help

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- and we encourage all exhibitors/parents to help with dismantling and cleaning your areas and pens. *It is not the responsibility of the staff or Fairboard directors and volunteers!
- (k) Superintendent reserves the right to add, delete or combine classes if necessary.

- (1) Barn closes to the public at 10:00 p.m. NO exhibitors to stay in the barn.
- (m) 4-H Club signs and displays encouraged.
- (n) "FAN" must be provided by Exhibitor for their animal's comfort.

- Ram Lamb $-3\frac{1}{2}$ mos. under one year of age as of July 1 of current year.
- Yearling Ewe over one year and under two years as of July 1 of current year.
- Mature Ewe over two years of age as of July 1 of current year.
- Group Class -youth exhibitor flock will contain from one breed: a ram and 2 ewes (each from a different age class-Mature, Yearling, Sr. or Jr. Ewe Lamb).
- 101 Feeder Lamb (under 85 lbs).

MARKET CLASSES

MARKET LAMB – 85-150 lbs. (All Market Animals will be weighted in on Tuesday evening starting at 7PM – Weigh-In Schedule will be posted).

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LADIES' AND GENTLEMEN'S LEADLINE CLASS

- Exhibitor must own the sheep and be between the ages of 8 to 19 years of age as of January 1st of current year. **Age**: **Ir Division (8-13) and Sr Division. (14-19)**
 - 1. Garments must be appropriate and attractive. Garments must have some part that is 100% wool or wool blend. The garment will be made by the exhibitor.
 - 2. The sheep must be an ewe shown in a class in the fair. The ewe must be conditioned, fitted and trained to show at halter. No coloring or decorating of sheep is permitted.
 - 3. A summary sheet must be presented to the superintendent prior to the show containing the name, address and age of the contestant, school attending, a brief

biography (i.e. hobbies, other interests, etc.), the breed of sheep being led, and a description of the garment the contestant will wear.

Scoring:Poise and appearance20 pointsGarments20 pointsControl and presentation of ewe25 pointsAppearance of the ewe35 points
