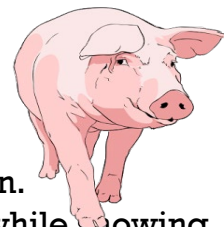

*Rules and Regulations 2020*

*New York State Livestock Requirements*

*& General Rules apply*



- (a) **CLOVERBUDS** will not be allowed to show in swine division.
- (b) Swine will be shown in the ring. Boards are not to be used while showing. Gilts may be shown in market or breed classes, BUT NOT BOTH.
- (c) No Boars allowed.
- (f) All swine exhibitors are required to enter a showmanship class and No farm shirts or any shirts with printing or design permitted in classes.
- (e) **ANIMAL PROJECT RECORD** - one project record is needed for one project animal that a 4-H'er has. If showing more than one species, the 4-H'er should only pick one animal. Website: <http://cortland.cce.cornell.edu/4-h-youth/cortland-jr-fair>
- (f) **NON-OWNED ANIMAL(s)** accompanied with a **non-ownership certificate** must be properly filled out, along with registration papers to prove designation.
  - Youth are **limited to ONE (1) non-owned animal** per species at the fair. (i.e. Beef, Poultry, Rabbits, Swine & Sheep)
  - Website: <http://cortland.cce.cornell.edu/4-h-youth/cortland-jr-fair>
  - Youth may register **TWO (2) Non-Owned Animal per species-** "**but may only show one**" at the fair. (Dairy Goats & Meat Goats).
  - **A designated non-owned project animal** must be shown **only by registered exhibitor** and not by youth owner and must accompany the animal entering the fairgrounds.
  - **Dual designation of one animal is not permitted.**
  - **No Non-Owned Animal in Market Class**
- (g) Exhibitor must have registration papers and non-owned certificate with the animal for check in – so that superintendent and veterinarian can authorize entry and housing.
- (h) Up-to-date **MARKET RECORDS** are mandatory for each animal.

**Note:** Market Sale Checks will be mailed to Exhibitor after fair, once exhibitor has met the **two final requirements listed:**

  - (1) Market Record Book must be turn in no later than Saturday, July 13<sup>th</sup> -10:00 a.m.
  - (2) Must help dismantle/clean of the swine area on Sunday, July 14<sup>th</sup> @ 6-8:00 a.m.
- (i) **MARKET HOG WEIGH-IN – Tuesday Evening starting at 7PM– a schedule will be posted. READ:GUIDELINES MARKET CLASS**
- (j) **NO NON-OWNED animals in Market Class.**
- (k) 4-H Club signs and displays encouraged.
- (l) **"FAN"** must be provided by Exhibitor for their animal's comfort.
- (m) Barn Closes to the public at 10:00 p.m. No non-exhibitors are allowed to stay in the barn unless they are immediate family. Lights Out in barn by 11:00 p.m.
- (n) **In Place:** Animals in place on Tuesday, 6:00 p.m.

**Released:** All animals will be released on Sunday between 6:00-8:00 a.m.

**Dismantle & Cleaning- Swine Area:** One (1) Rep from Club/family **MUST** be present to help and we encourage all exhibitors/parents to help with dismantling and

cleaning your areas and pens. *\*It is not the responsibility of the staff or Fairboard directors and volunteers!*

**SWINE SHOWMANSHIP –**  
**Wednesday, July 8<sup>th</sup> ♦ 11AM - Pole Barn Arena**

- 104 First Year Showperson - 8 - 13 years of age
- 105 First Year Showperson - 14 - 19 years of age
- 106 Jr. Showmanship - 8 - 13 years of age
- 107 Sr. Showmanship - 14 - 19 years of age
- 108 Grand Champion Showperson Top (2) from each of previous classes competed.

**~BREEDING AND MARKET CLASSES~**

- 109 Sr. Fall Gilt – farrowed on or after July 1 of preceding year
- 110 January Spring Gilt – Farrowed during January of current year
- 111 February Spring Gilt – Farrow during February of current year
- 112 Junior Spring Gilt – Farrowed on or after March 1 of current year

**MARKET CLASSES:** *(All Animals will be weighed in on Tuesday evening starting at 7PM - Weight-In Schedule will be posted)* **Note: Rabies Requirement!**

- Groups will be determined by a “sort of the weights” of the entered animals.
- Based on this sort, entries will be divided into approximately **four (4) equal weight Groups:** *(source: 2014 NYS Fair Youth Livestock-page 109)*

**LIGHT WEIGHT - INTERMEDIATE WEIGHT – MEDIUM WEIGHT - HEAVY WEIGHT**

- 113 **Feeder Market Hog** – (underweight) not eligible for Grand/Res.Champion honors or for the Market Sale.
- 114 Light Market Hog ***\*minimum of 200 lbs.*** \*eligible for Grand/Res. Champion honors
- 115 Medium Market Hog \*eligible for Grand Res. Champion honors
- 116 Intermediate Weight Market Hog \*eligible for Grand/Res. Champion honors
- 117 Heavy Market Hog ***\*maximum of 300 lbs.*** \*eligible for Grand/Res. Champion honors
- 118 Overweight Hog ***\*Over 300 lbs.*** \*not eligible for Grand/Res. Champion honors

**\*CLASSES: #114-117 ARE ELIGIBLE FOR CHAMPION & RESERVE CHAMPION HONORS**

**Market Sale Checks** will be mailed to Exhibitor after fair, once exhibitor has met the **two final requirements listed:**

- (1.) Market Record Book must be turn in no later than Saturday, July 11<sup>th</sup> -10:00 a.m.
- (2.) Must help dismantle/clean of the swine area on Sunday, July 12<sup>th</sup> - 6-8:00 a.m.

**All awards are listed in the back of the fair book and may be changed or deleted if necessary by staff or judge.**
