Dairy Cattle Barn Rules and Regulations 2020 New York State Livestock Requirements & General Rules apply



- (a) **CLOVERBUDS** will not be allowed to show in swine division. l
- (b) Swine will be shown in the ring. Boards are not to be used while showing. Gilts may be shown in market or breed classes, BUT NOT BOTH.
- (c) No Boars allowed.
- (f) All swine exhibitors are required to enter a showmanship class and No farm shirts or any shirts with printing or design permitted in classes.
- (e) **ANIMAL PROJECT RECORD** one project record is needed for one project animal that a 4-H'er has. If showing more than one species, the 4-H'er should only pick one animal. Website: <u>http://cortland.cce.cornell.edu/4-h-youth/cortland-jr-fair</u>
- (f) NON-OWNED ANIMAL(s) accompanied with a **non-ownership certificate** must be properly filled out, along with registration papers to prove designation.
 - Youth are <u>limited to ONE (1) non-owned animal</u> per species at the fair. (i.e. Beef, Poultry, Rabbits, Swine & Sheep)
 - Website: <u>http://cortland.cce.cornell.edu/4-h-youth/cortland-jr-fair</u>
 - Youth may register **TWO (2)** <u>Non-Owned Animal per species</u>- "but may only show one" at the fair. (Dairy Goats & Meat Goats).
 - A designated non-owned project animal must be shown <u>only by registered exhibitor</u> and not by youth owner and must accompany the animal entering the fairgrounds.
 - Dual designation of one <u>animal is not permitted</u>.
 - No Non-Owned Animal in Market Class
- (g) Exhibitor must have registration papers and non-owned certificate with the animal for check in so that superintendent and veterinarian can authorize entry and housing.

(h) Up-to-date MARKET RECORDS are mandatory for each animal.

Note: Market Sale Checks will be mailed to Exhibitor after fair, once exhibitor has met the **two final requirements listed**:

- (1) Market Record Book must be turn in no later than Saturday, July 13th -10:00 a.m. (2) Must help dismantle/clean of the swine area on Sunday, July 14th @ 6-8:00 a.m.
- (i) MARKET HOG WEIGH-IN Tuesday Evening starting at 7PM– a schedule will be posted. READ:GUIDELINES MARKET CLASS
- (j) NO NON-OWNED animals in Market Class.
- (k) 4-H Club signs and displays encouraged.
- (1) "FAN" must be provided by Exhibitor for their animal's comfort.
- (m) Barn Closes to the public at 10:00 p.m. No non-exhibitors are allowed to stay in the barn unless they are immediate family. Lights Out in barn by 11:00 p.m.
- In Place: Animals in place on Tuesday, 6:00 p.m.
 Released: All animals will be released on Sunday between 6:00-8:00 a.m.
 Dismantle & Cleaning- Swine Area: One (1) Rep from Club/family MUST be present to help and we encourage all exhibitors/parents to help with dismantling and

cleaning your areas and pens. *It is not the responsibility of the staff or Fairboard directors and volunteers!
