Grand Master Showman Competition at the Cortland County Jr. Youth fair is one of the most prestigious honors at the fair. The contest includes the Master showman in different divisions; dairy goat, meat goat, sheep, swine, dairy cattle and beef cattle.

GRAND MASTER SHOWMAN COMPETITION RULES:

- 1. Open to all Master Showman from the Dairy Cattle, Dairy Goat, Meat Goat, Beef, Sheep, and Swine Project Areas.
- 2. In the event that a youth is selected Master Showman from more than 1 area, that youth will have the <u>option to choose which species</u> they will represent in the Master Showman competition. The Reserve Master Showmen may have the opportunity to compete from the subsequent area.
- 3. Scoring will be as follows: 1st place = 1pt, 2nd place = 2pts, etc. The person with the lowest point tally will be named winner.
- 4. Participants may only win once within 4-H age categories of Jr. 8-13 and Sr. 14-19.
- 5. Master Showmen in each species will provide a short demonstration on their animal at the beginning of the contest and will be judged on their own animal.
- **6.** Participants will wear clean show outfit with closed toed shoes for contest. Grand Master Showman will receive a trophy.
