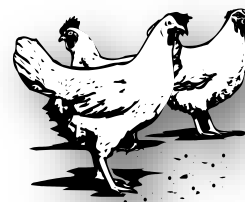


## SECTION 09 – POULTRY - Ag Corporation Building

*Rules and Regulations 2021*  
*New York State Livestock Requirements*  
*& General Rules apply*



- (a) New York State Regulations and General Rules apply.
- (b) Pullorum testing is required before entering the fairgrounds.
- (c) A clinic will be held prior to fair – contact office for date and time.  
Do not bring any birds to the fair if they are, or appear to be, affected with any contagious disease. Birds must be **show quality condition**: clean, healthy, vigorous, mature, fully feathered, and free of lice and mites.
- (d) Ownership of Poultry Exhibits **must be by June 1<sup>st</sup> of current year.**  
**All Poultry Exhibits will be in place TUESDAY AT 10:00 A.M.**
- The exhibitor is responsible for placing their exhibits in the cage/coop(s).
  - Exhibitor meeting by Superintendent shortly after 10AM
  - Each exhibitor is to feed and water his/her own exhibits.
  - Each exhibitor must help wash & clean their cage/coops(s) at the end of fair and to help with dismantling the area.
- (e) Double entry cards must be used and must be filled out properly attaching the entry tag (white color) to the coop. Otherwise, the exhibit will not be judged.
- (f) **CLOVERBUDS** are allowed to show only one (1) entry in Showmanship Class.
- (g) All exhibitors are required to participate in the showmanship class.
- (h) A **maximum of 10 Birds** per exhibitor.
- (i) Judging will be on TUESDAY with showmanship classes first. (Only exhibitors will be allowed in roped-off area at judging time).
- (j) **ANIMAL PROJECT RECORD** - one project record is needed for one project animal that a 4-H'er has. If showing more than one species, the 4-H'er should only pick one animal. Website: <http://cortland.cce.cornell.edu/4-h-youth/cortland-jr-fair>
- (k) **NON-OWNED ANIMAL(s)** accompanied with a **non-ownership certificate** must be properly filled out, along with registration papers to prove designation.
- Youth are **limited to ONE (1) non-owned animal** per species at the fair. (i.e. Beef, Poultry, Rabbits, Swine & Sheep)

- Section 10 -POULTRY**
- Youth may register **TWO (2) Non-Owned Animal per species**- "**but may only show one**" at the fair. (i.e. Dairy Goats & Meat Goats).
  - **A designated non-owned project animal** must be shown only by registered exhibitor and not by youth owner and must accompany the animal entering the fairgrounds.
  - **Dual designation of one animal is not permitted.**
  - **No Non-Owned Animal in Market Class**
- (m) **Poultry Clean Up:** All exhibitors must come on Sunday Morning, to scrub and wash their cages & pens before dismantling and putting away.

(n) **READ INSERT GUIDELINES FOR MARKET CLASSES:**

**\*Up-to-date Project Records are mandatory\*** (Turkeys & Broilers)

**Note:** market Sale checks will be mailed to exhibitor after fair, once exhibitor has met the two final requirements listed:

1. Market Record Book must be turned in by Saturday, July 10<sup>th</sup> by 10:00 a.m.
2. Must help dismantle/clean of the poultry area Sunday, July 11<sup>th</sup> at 6-8:00 a.m.

Premiums and Market proceeds will be withheld if records are not turned in.

4-H Club signs and displays are encouraged.

(o) Barn Closes to the public at 10:00 p.m. – **NO one is allowed** to stay overnight in the Ag. Corp. Building.

(p) Fans - Must be provided by exhibitor.

**POULTRY BREED CLASSES:**

**Class**

- 121 Cock - male bird hatched prior to 1/01/20  
122 Hen - female bird hatched prior to 1/01/20  
123 Cockerel - male bird hatched 1/01/20 or after  
124 Pullet - female bird hatched 1/01/20 or after  
125 Egg Class - (1) one dozen: same species, same color – from your own birds.

**~ OTHER POULTRY CLASSES ~**

**Ducks, Geese, Turkey, Guineas, Pheasants, Quail and Pigeons**

- 126 Single or Pair born prior to 1/01/19  
127 Single or Pair born 1/01/19 or after  
128 Poster Contest – posters must be 22” x 28 to be hung in area. (**Fair theme is: “Grow with 4-H Green”**).  
**All Animals will be weighed in on Tuesday evening starting at 7PM**  
**Weigh-In Schedule will be posted - Read Guidelines for Market Animals**
