Rules and Regulations 2023 New York State Livestock Requirement & General Rules apply



- (a) Cattle BVD-PI testing Negative Results
- (b) Up-to-date Market Records are mandatory for each animal. Records are to be turned in to the 4-H Fair Office immediately after the sale. Premiums will be withheld if records are not turned in.
- (c) Registered beef cattle must be registered in exhibitor's name with the appropriate National Breed Registry.
- (d) Animals must conform to a <u>standard beef type</u>. Dairy or Dairy cross steers are eligible. Must have been under the care and supervision of the exhibitor by **June lst of current year**.
- (e) All animals must be shown on a halter and trained to lead prior to enter the ring.
- (f) NO bulls over 6 months of age are allowed at the fair.
- (g) **CLOVERBUDS** <u>may not show</u> in this division.
- (h) All beef exhibitors are required to enter a showmanship class.
 ANIMAL PROJECT RECORD one project record is needed for one project animal that a 4-H'er has. If showing more than one species, the 4-H'er should only pick one animal. Website: <u>http://cortland.cce.cornell.edu/4-h-youth/cortland-jr-fair</u>
- (i) NON-OWNED ANIMAL(s) accompanied with a non-ownership certificate must be properly filled out, along with registration papers to prove designation.
 - Youth are <u>limited to ONE (1) non-owned animal</u> per species at the fair. (i.e. Beef, Poultry, Rabbits, Swine & Sheep)
 - Website: <u>http://cortland.cce.cornell.edu/4-h-youth/cortland-jr-fair</u>
 - Youth may register **TWO (2)** <u>Non-Owned Animal per species</u>- "*but may only show one*" at the fair. (i.e. Dairy Goats & Meat Goats).
 - A designated non-owned project animal must be shown <u>only by registered exhibitor</u> and not by youth owner and must accompany the animal entering the fairgrounds.
 - Dual designation of one <u>animal is not permitted</u>.
 - No Non-Owned Animal in Market Class
- (j) Exhibitor must have all certification papers and/or non-owned certificate with the animal for check in, so that superintendent and veterinarian can authorize entry.
- (k) Heifer Calf shown in cow/calf class can be shown in Jr. Heifer class.
- (1) Showmanship is required of all exhibitors.
- (m) All animal fitting must be done by youth exhibitor ages 8 & up. Adult help is allowed but the majority must be done by the youth.
- (n) Animal shown in a breed classes cannot be shown in a market class, other than a calf in a cow/calf pair.
- (o) There will be only one premium per class per exhibitor.
- (p) All first place blue ribbon animals, along with the second place blue ribbon animals are eligible for the Grand Champion and Res. Grand Champion awards.
- (q) <u>READ GUIDELINES FOR MARKET CLASS</u> Note: Market Sale Checks will be

mailed to Exhibitor after fair, once exhibitor has met the **<u>two final requirements</u> <u>listed</u>**:

1. Market Record Book must be turn in no later than Saturday, July 8^{th} -10:00 a.m.

- 2. Must help dismantle/clean of the sheep area on Sunday, July 9th @ 6-8:00 a.m.
- (r) No non-owned animals in Market Class.
- (s) 4-H Club signs and displays encouraged. **Fans** must be provided by exhibitor for animal's comfort.

In Place: Animals in place on Tuesday, 6:00 p.m.

Released: All animals will be released on Sunday between 6:00-8:00 a.m.

Dismantle & Cleaning: We ask all exhibitors/parents to help with dismantling and cleaning your areas and pens. **It is not the responsibility of the staff or Fairboard directors and volunteers!*
