SECTION 08 - SWINE Wednesday, July 5th - Livestock Shows-11AM-3PM

Dairy Cattle Barn Rules and Regulations 2023 New York State Livestock Requirements & General Rules apply

- (a) **CLOVERBUDS** will not be allowed to show in swine division.
- (b) Swine will be shown in the ring. Boards are not to be used while showing. Gilts may be shown in market or breed classes, BUT NOT BOTH.
- (c) No Boars allowed.
- (f) Showmanship class is required of all exhibitors
- (e) All animal fitting must be done by youth exhibitor ages 8 & up. Adult help is allowed but the majority must be done by the youth.
- (f) No farm shirts or any shirts with printing or design permitted in classes.
- (g) ANIMAL PROJECT RECORD one project record is needed for one project animal that a 4-H'er has. If showing more than one species, the 4-H'er should only pick one animal. Website: http://cortland.cce.cornell.edu/4-h-youth/cortland-jr-fair
- (h) NON-OWNED ANIMAL(s) accompanied with a non-ownership certificate must be properly filled out, along with registration papers to prove designation.
 - Youth are <u>limited to ONE (1) non-owned animal</u> per species at the fair. (i.e. Beef, Poultry, Rabbits, Swine & Sheep)
 - Website: http://cortland.cce.cornell.edu/4-h-youth/cortland-jr-fair
 - Youth may register **TWO** (2) <u>Non-Owned Animal per species</u>- "but may only show one" at the fair. (Dairy Goats & Meat Goats).
 - A designated non-owned project animal must be shown only by registered exhibitor and not by youth owner and must accompany the animal entering the fairgrounds.
 - Dual designation of one animal is not permitted.
 - No Non-Owned Animal in Market Class
- (i) Exhibitor must have registration papers and non-owned certificate with the animal for check in so that superintendent and veterinarian can authorize entry and housing.
- (j) Up-to-date **MARKET RECORDS** are mandatory for each animal.
 - **Note:** Market Sale Checks will be mailed to Exhibitor after fair, once exhibitor has met the **two final requirements listed**:
 - (1) Market Record Book must be turn in no later than Saturday, July 8th -10:00 a.m.
 - (2) Must help dismantle/clean of the swine area on Sunday, July 9^{th} @ 6-8:00 a.m.
- (k) MARKET HOG WEIGH-IN Tuesday Evening starting at 7-8PM- (a schedule will be posted). READ:GUIDELINES MARKET CLASS
- (1) NO NON-OWNED animals in Market Class.
- (m) 4-H Club signs and displays encouraged.
- (n) Fans must be provided by Exhibitor for their animal's comfort.

(o) Barn Closes to the public at 10:00 p.m. No non-exhibitors are allowed to stay in the barn unless they are immediate family. Lights Out in barn by 11:00 p.m.

In Place: Animals in place on Tuesday, 6:00 p.m.

Released: All animals will be released on Sunday between 6:00-8:00 a.m.

Dismantle & Cleaning- Swine Area: One (1) Rep from Club/family MUST be present to help and we encourage all exhibitors/parents to help with dismantling and cleaning your areas and pens. *It is not the responsibility of the staff or Fairboard directors and volunteers!

- Groups will be determined by a "sort of the weights" of the entered animals.
- Based on this sort, entries will be divided into approximately **four (4) equal weight Groups**: (source: 2014 NYS Fair Youth Livestock-page 109)

LIGHT WEIGHT - INTERMEDIATE WEIGHT - MEDIUM WEIGHT - HEAVY WEIGHT

- **Feeder Market Hog** (underweight) not eligible for Grand/Res.Champion honors or for the Market Sale.
- 114 Light Market Hog *minimum of 200 lbs. *eligible for Grand/Res. Champion honors
- 115 Medium Market Hog
- *eligible for Grand Res. Champion honors
- 116 Intermediate Weight Market Hog
- *eligible for Grand/Res. Champion honors
- 117 Heavy Market Hog *maximum of 300 lbs.
- *eligible for Grand/Res. Champion honors
- 118 Overweight Hog *Over 300 lbs.
- *not eligible for Grand/Res. Champion honors
