
Inside A Chicken Egg



The eggshell protects the inside of the egg.

Color the eggshell brown.

air pocket -

The two membranes protect the insides, too.

Color the membranes blue.

The **albumen** keeps the embryo moist. Leave the albumen white.

The **yolk** provides food for the growing embryo.

Color the yolk yellow.

The **embryo** grows into a chick.

Color the embryo red.

The **air pocket** holds air that the chick will breathe just before hatching. Leave the air pocket white.
