- (a) ADGA tattoo is acceptable identification for <u>scrapie requirements</u> when animal is accompanied by registration papers. <u>No Ear Tags are required!</u>
- **Ownership:** A duplicate registration application from ADGA will be accepted on an animal under 6 months of age on a registered or recorded animal, a signed bill of sale or certificate of transfer attached to the duplicate will be accepted.
- (c) Dairy goats must be owned and registered in the exhibitor's name by **June 1, 2024**.
- (d) NON-OWNED ANIMAL(s) accompanied with a **non-ownership certificate** must be properly filled out, along with registration papers to prove designation.
 - Youth are limited to ONE (1) non-owned dairy goat per species at the fair.
 - Website: http://cortland.cce.cornell.edu/4-h-youth/cortland-jr-fair
 - Youth may register TWO (2) <u>Non-Owned Animal per species</u>- "but may only show one" at the fair.
 - only by registered exhibitor and not by youth owner and must accompany the animal entering the fairgrounds.
 - Dual designation of one animal is not permitted.
 - No Non-Owned Animal in Market Class
 - (e) Only does registered or recorded with ADGA, AGS or CGS are eligible for State Fair contests.
 - (f) No Bucks may be shown and no animals with horns may be shown.
 - (g) Entry Limit: a maximum 10 entries per exhibitor will be permitted. Premiums will be paid on a maximum of ONE animal per class, per exhibitor.
 - (h) ANIMAL PROJECT RECORD one project record is needed for one project animal that a 4-H'er has. If showing more than one species, the 4-H'er should only pick one animal. Website: http://cortland.cce.cornell.edu/4-h-youth/cortland-jr-fair
 - (i) Exhibitor must have registration papers and/or non-owned certificate with the animal for vet check in to authorize entry and housing.
 - (j) Showmanship is required of all exhibitors.
 - (k) All animal fitting must be done by youth exhibitor ages 8 & up. Adult help is allowed but the majority must be done by the youth.
 - (1) Jr. Division Does under 24 months of age -not in milk and have never freshened.
 - (m) Senior Division consists of milking does of any age, including dry and precocious milker (does 24 mos. & over that have <u>never freshened</u> will not be shown).
 - (n) Exhibitors to be dressed in show whites (no advertising/or farm name on clothing).
 - (o) Milking competition will not be available for the 2024 Jr. Fair
 - (p) 4-H Club signs and displays encouraged
 - (q) Fans must be provided by Exhibitor for their animal's comfort.
 - (r) Barn closes at 10:00 p.m. Lights out 11:00 p.m.! No exhibitors to stay in the barn.
 - (s) In Place: Animals in place on Tuesday, 6:00 p.m.

Released: All animals will be released on Sunday between 6:00-8:00 a.m.

<u>SENIOR DOES</u>: Consists of milking does of any age, including dry and precocious milkers. (Does - age 24 months and over that have never freshened will not be shown).

- 49 Younger than 2 years of age (in milk)
- 2 years to younger than 3 years of age
- 3 years to younger than 5 years of age
- 52 5 years of age and older
